

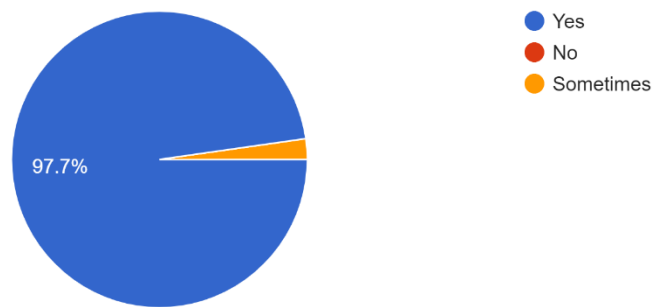

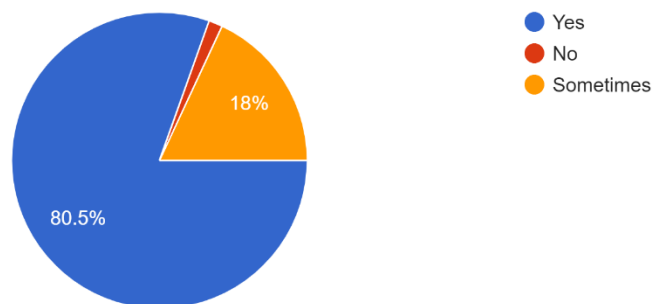
The school is welcoming and accessible to all pupils

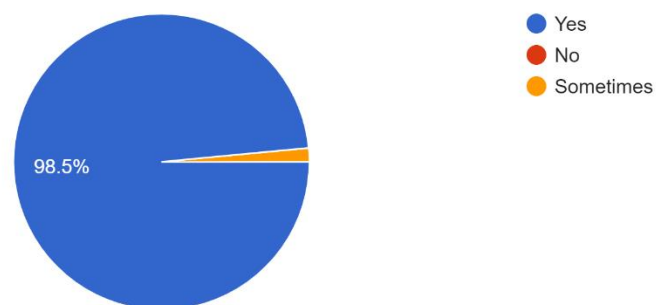
The school is welcoming and accessible to parents/carers

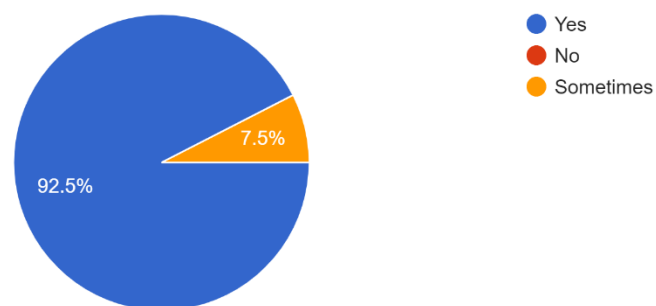
The school is well kept and bright

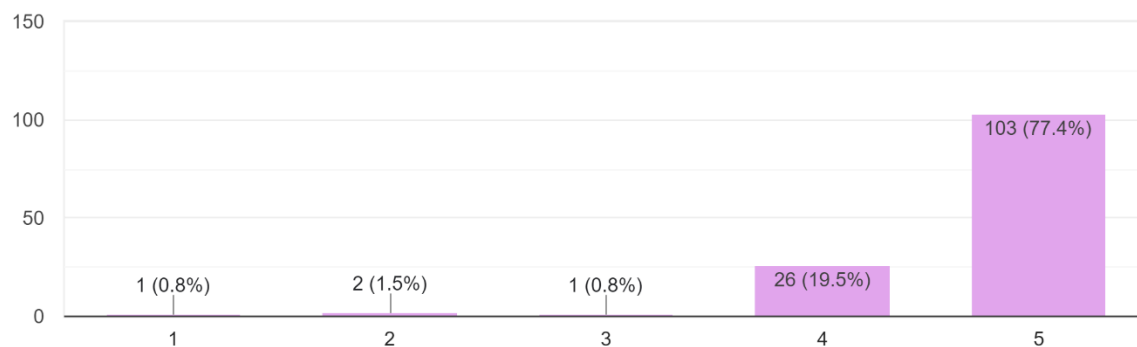

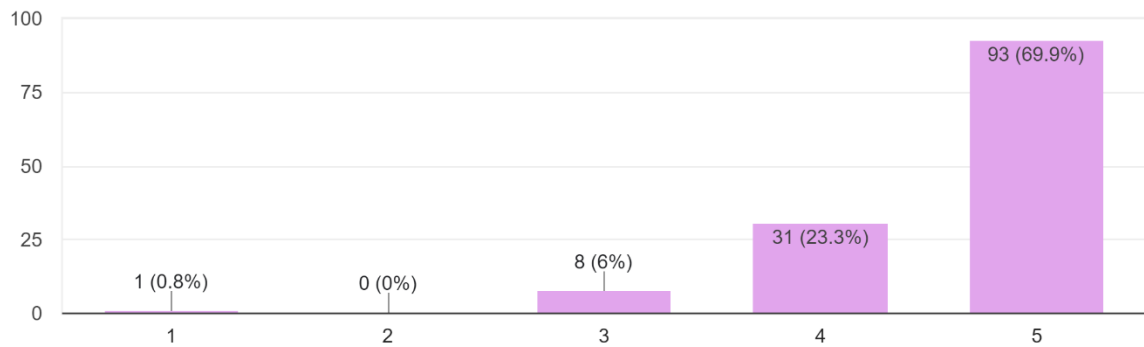

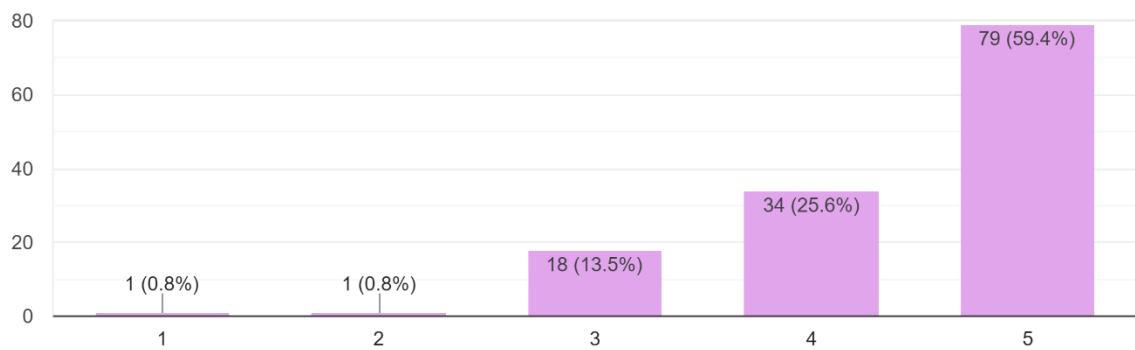
My child feels connected and part of the school community

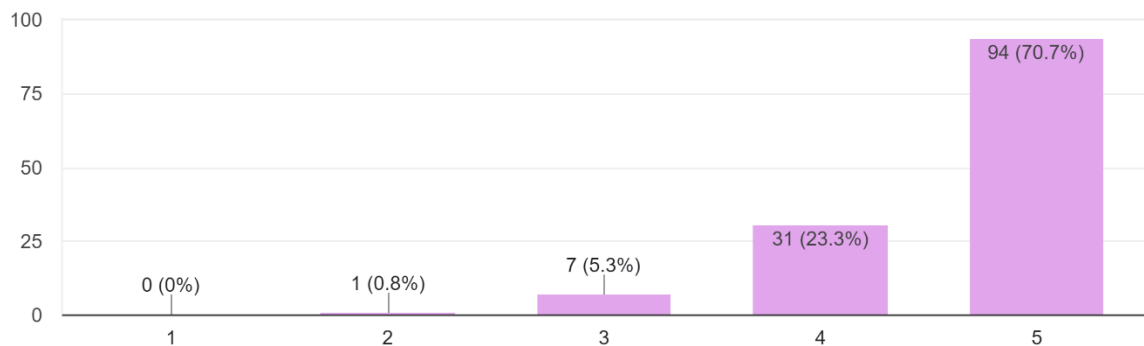
The school is committed to dealing with bullying and it's prevention

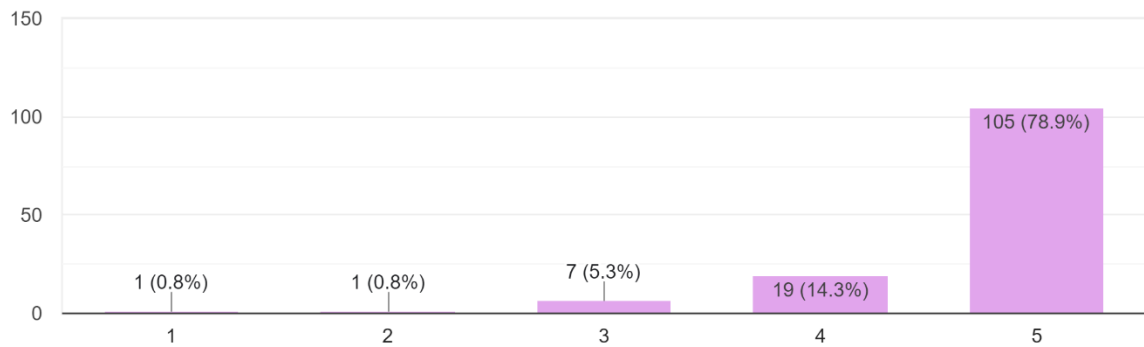
My child reports that school staff interact with her in a calm and respectful manner

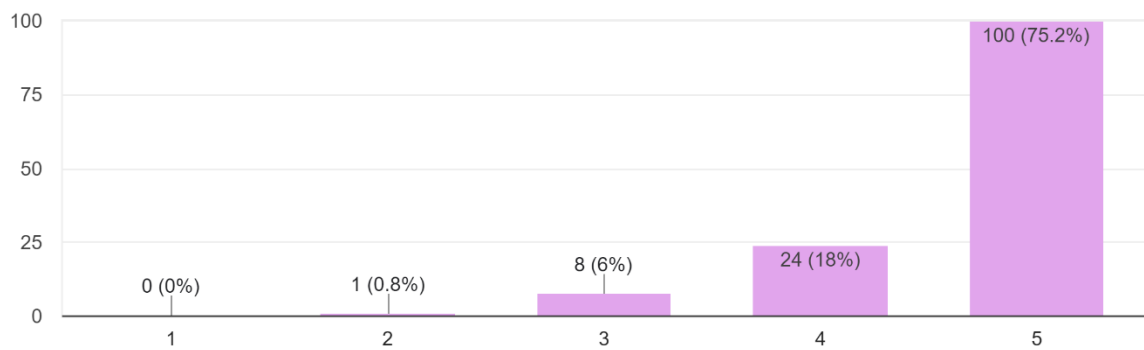
The school sees health and wellbeing as being important

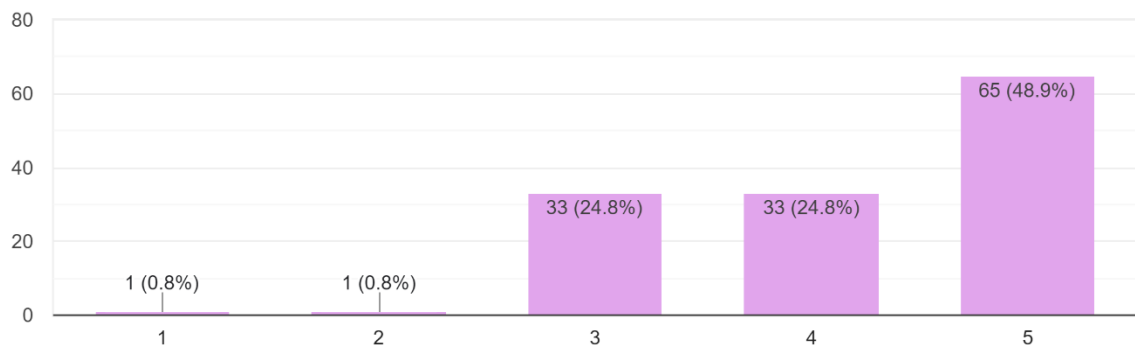
The school encourages the idea of every child doing their best

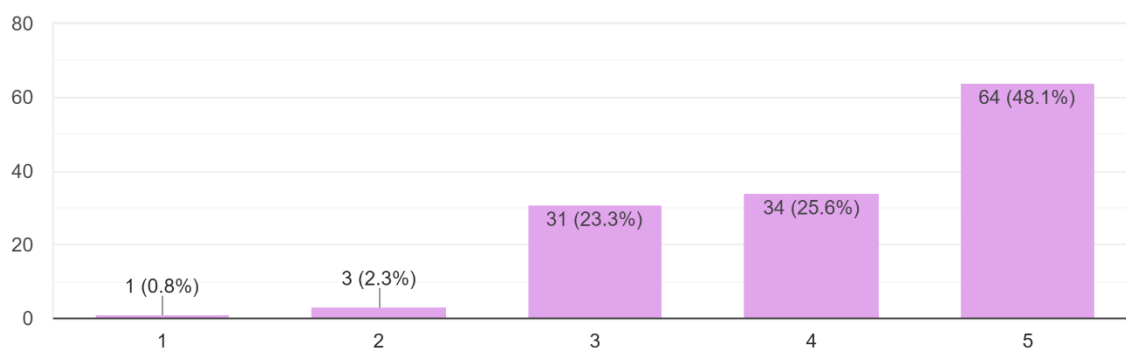
The school looks and listens to my child's opinions when developing school policies and plans.

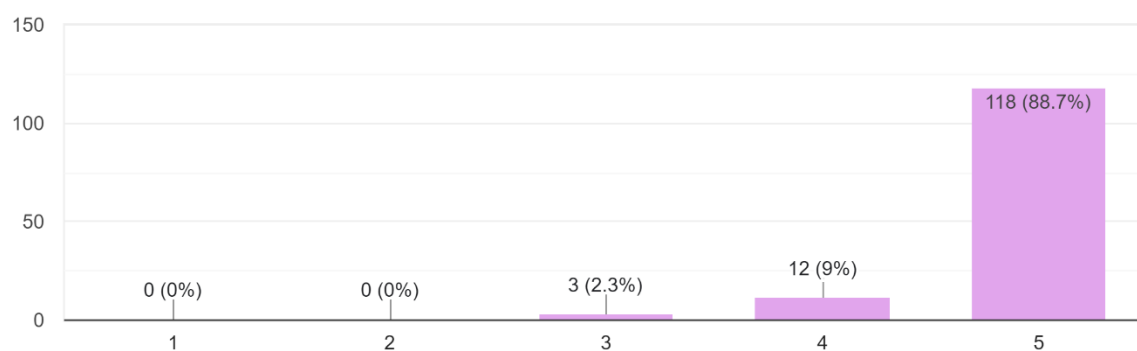
The school looks for and listens to parents views when planning and developing policies.

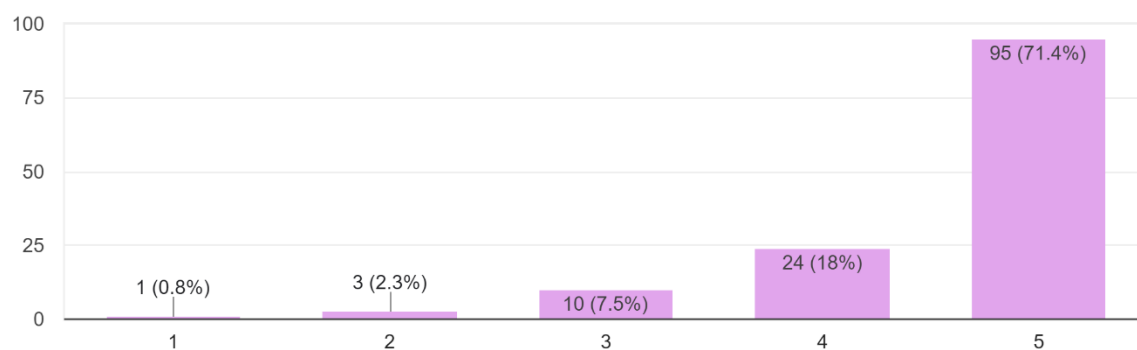
The school promotes healthy eating and encourages students to be physically active

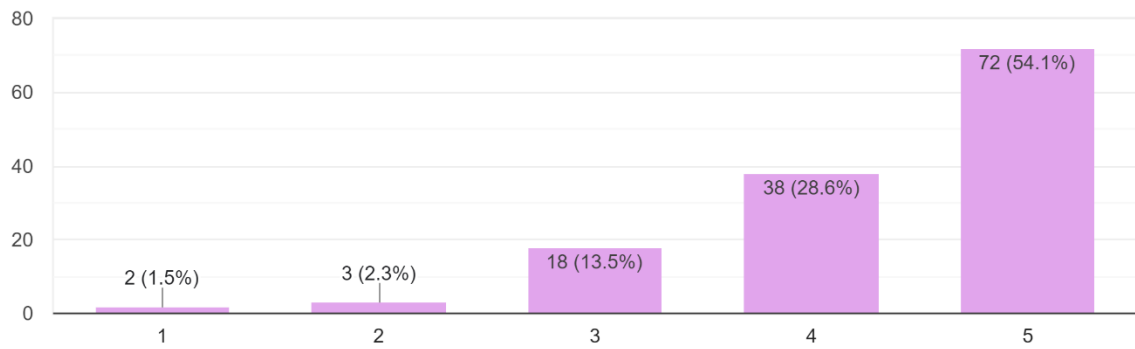

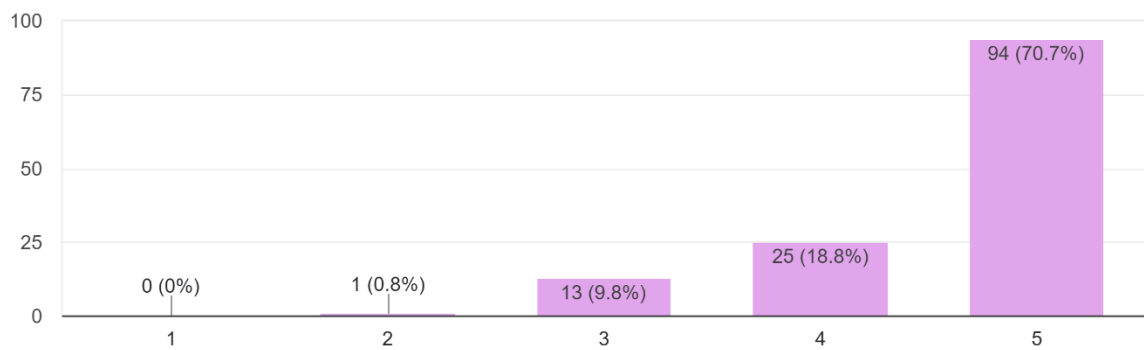

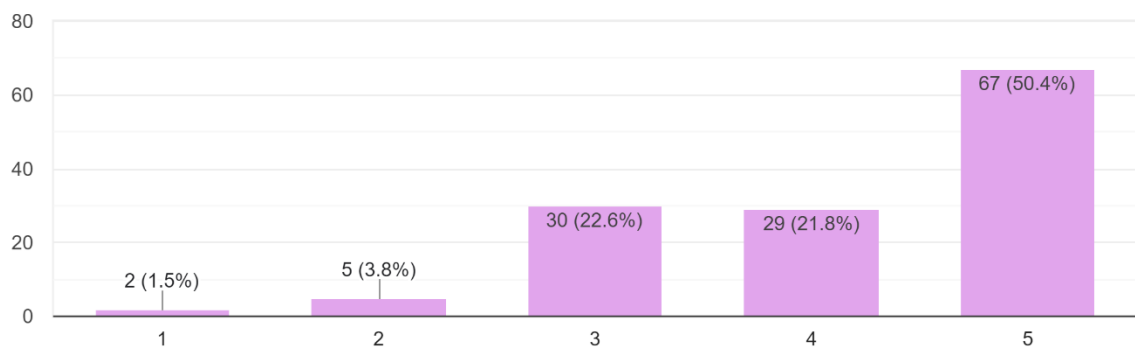
I feel that school staff are sensitive to confidential information that I share with them about my child

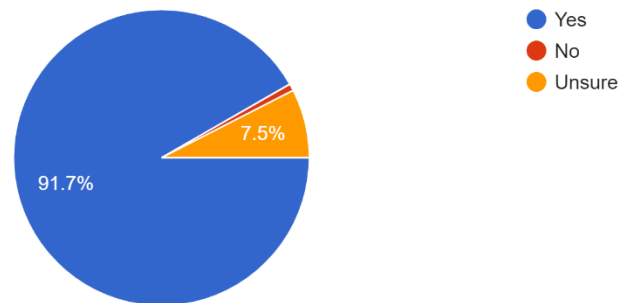

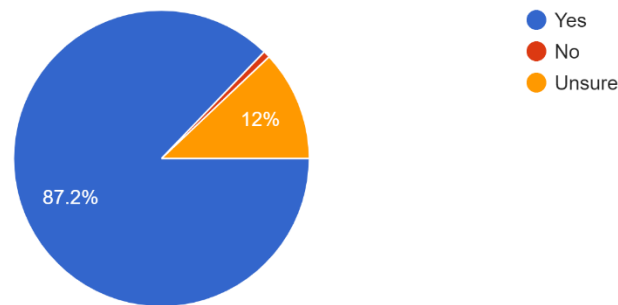
There are structures in the school which allow parents to have a voice (e.g. Parents Committee, Parents Meetings)

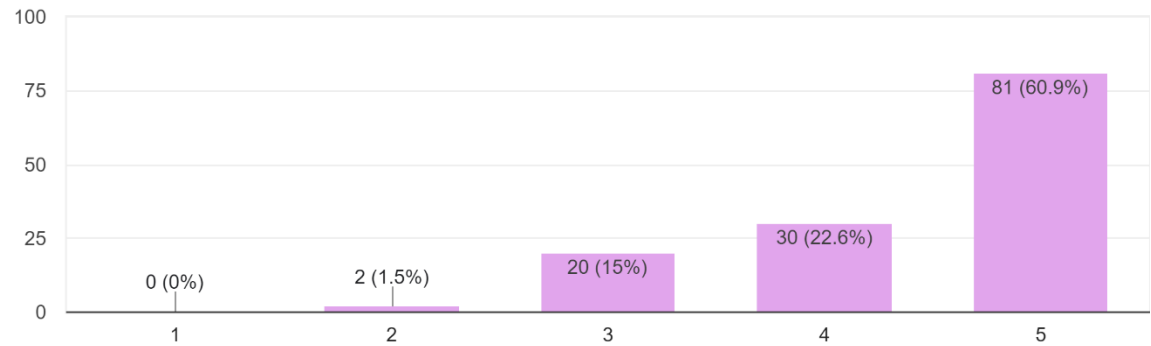
I am encouraged to support and be involved in different school activities.

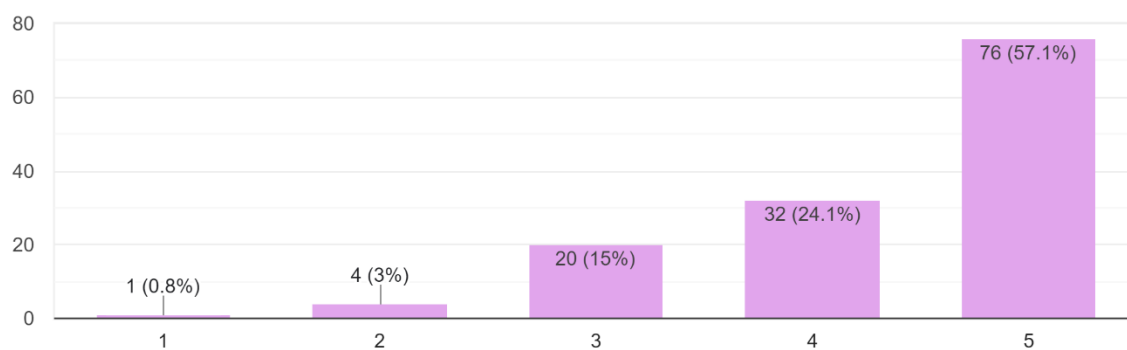
My child knows who to talk to in school if they have a concern.
