



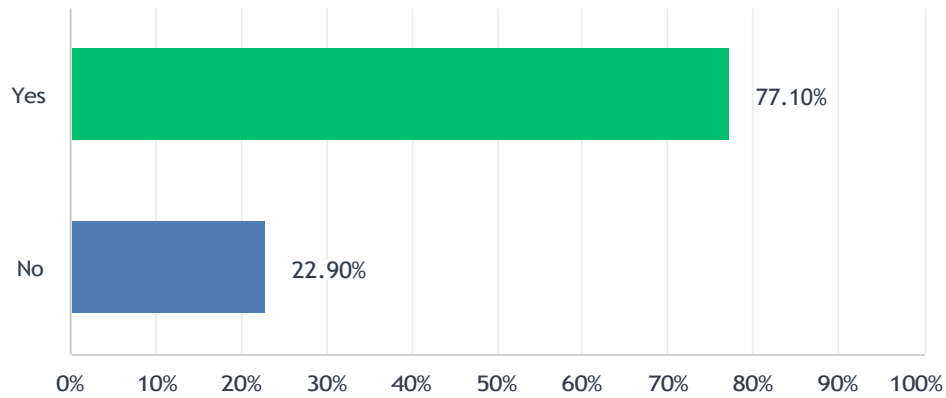

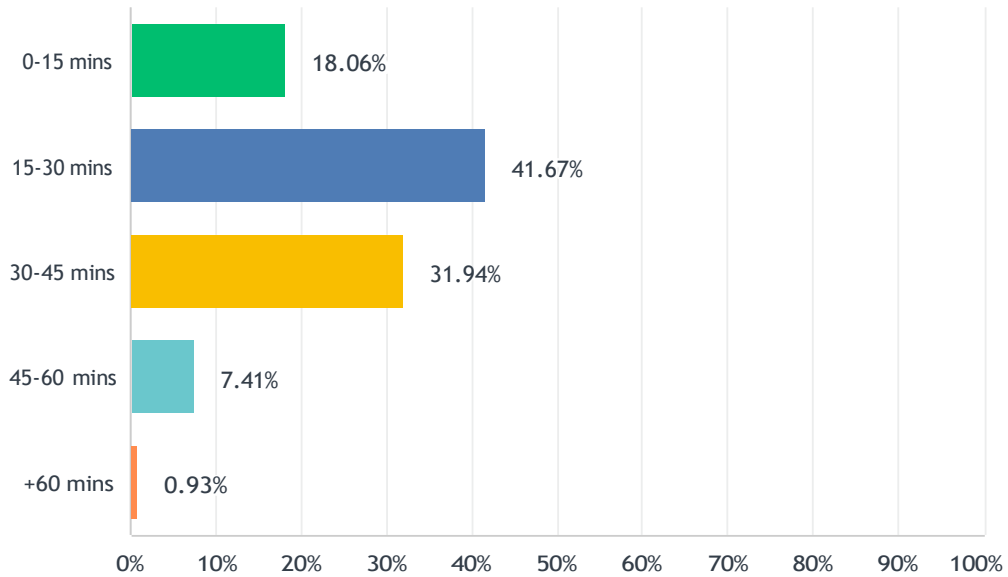
Q1 Do you think homework is beneficial to your child?

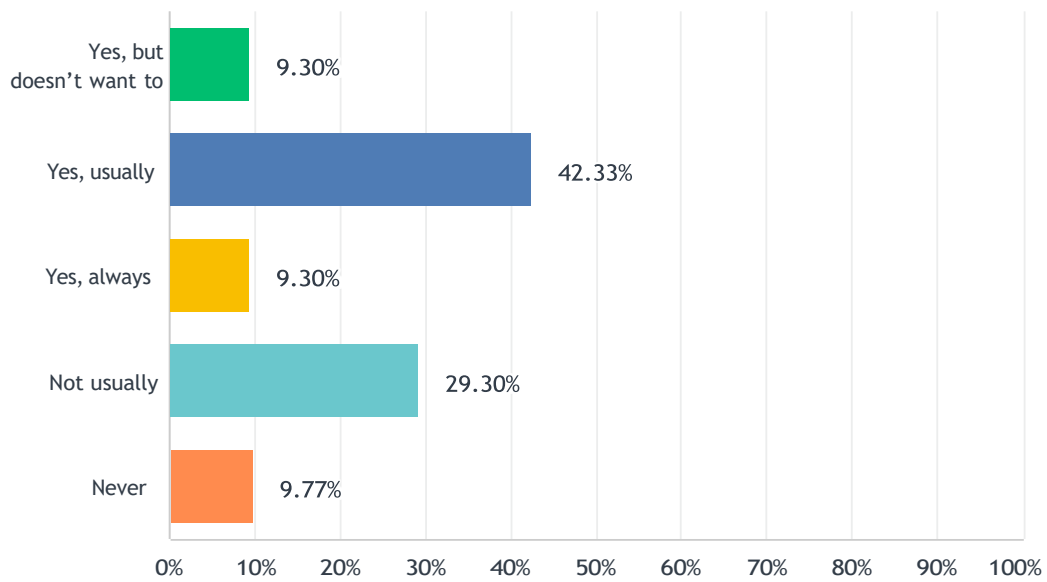
Q2 How much time does your child spend on homework every night?

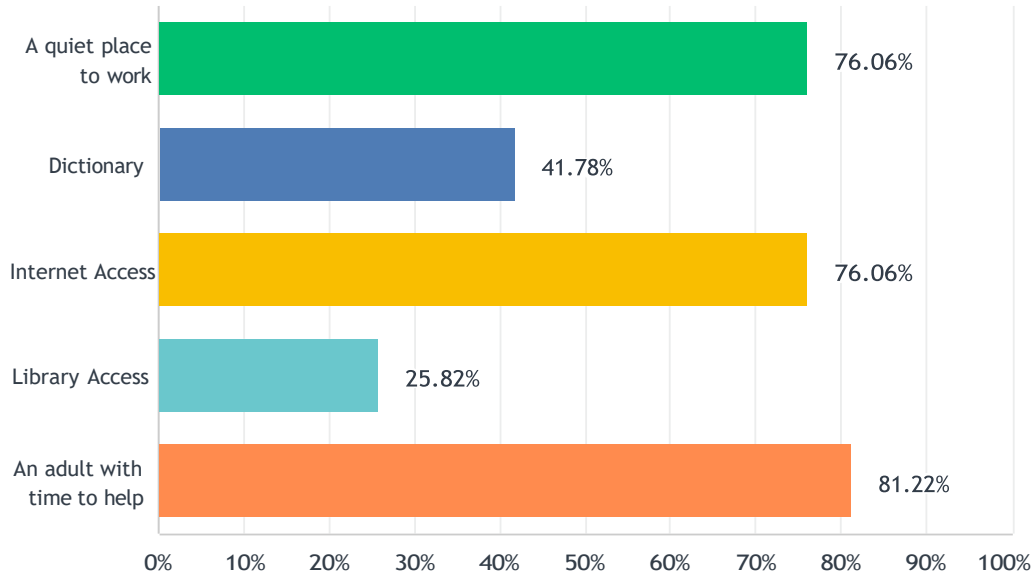
Q3 Can your child complete homework without your help or supervision?

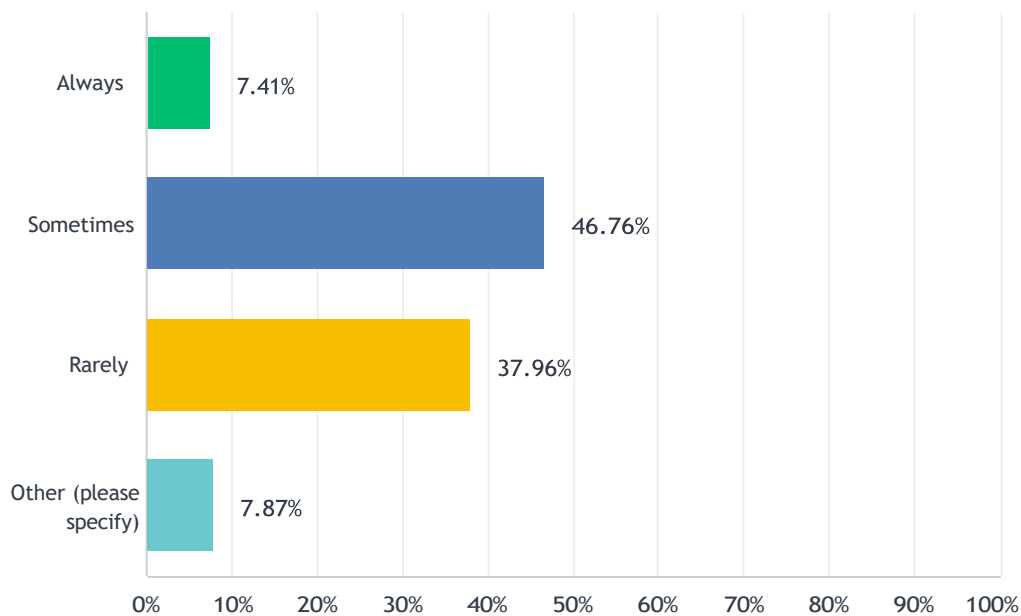
Q4 What resources do you have at home to assist your child in doing homework? (Check all that apply).

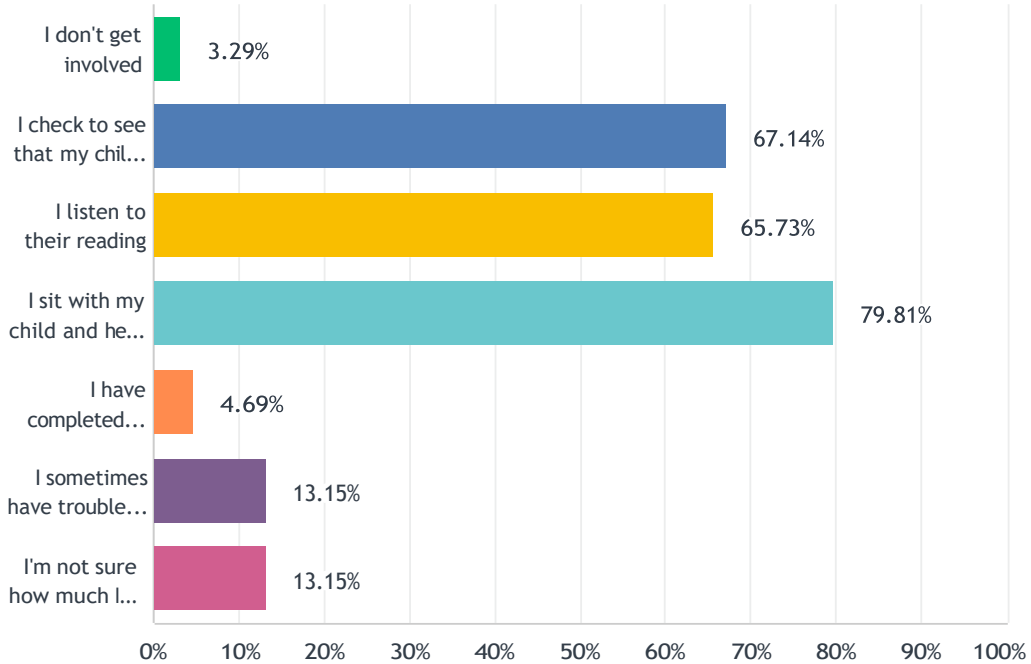
Q5 Does homework cause tension at home between you and your child?

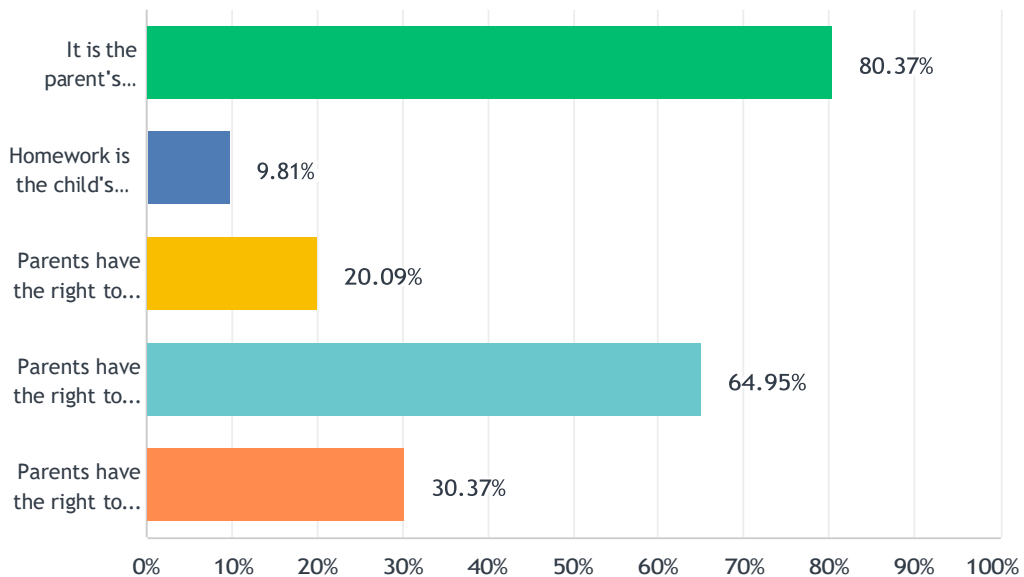
Q6 How are you involved in your child's homework? (Check all that apply to you)

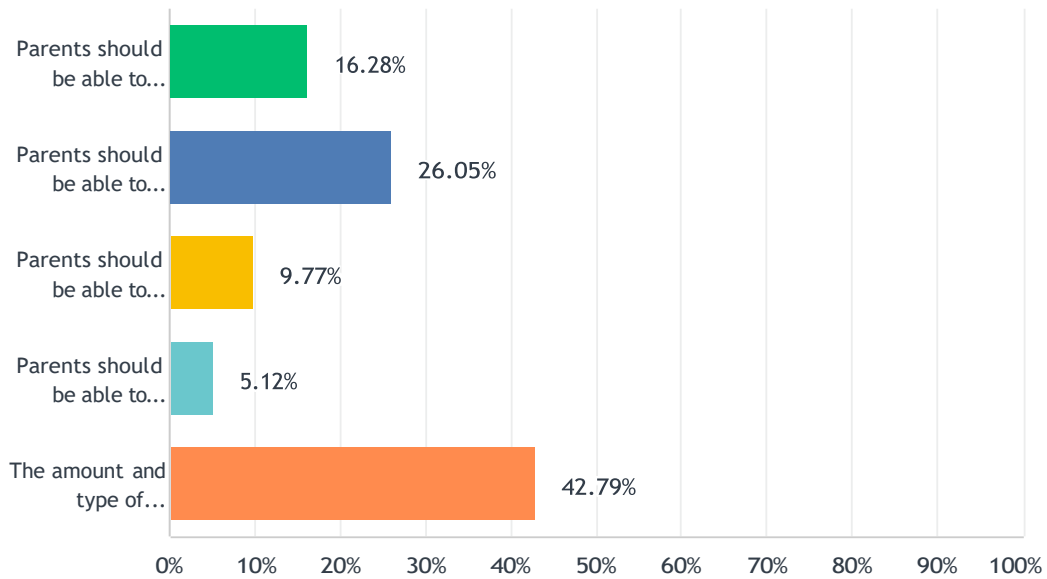
Q7 In your opinion who is charge of homework? (Check all that you agree with)

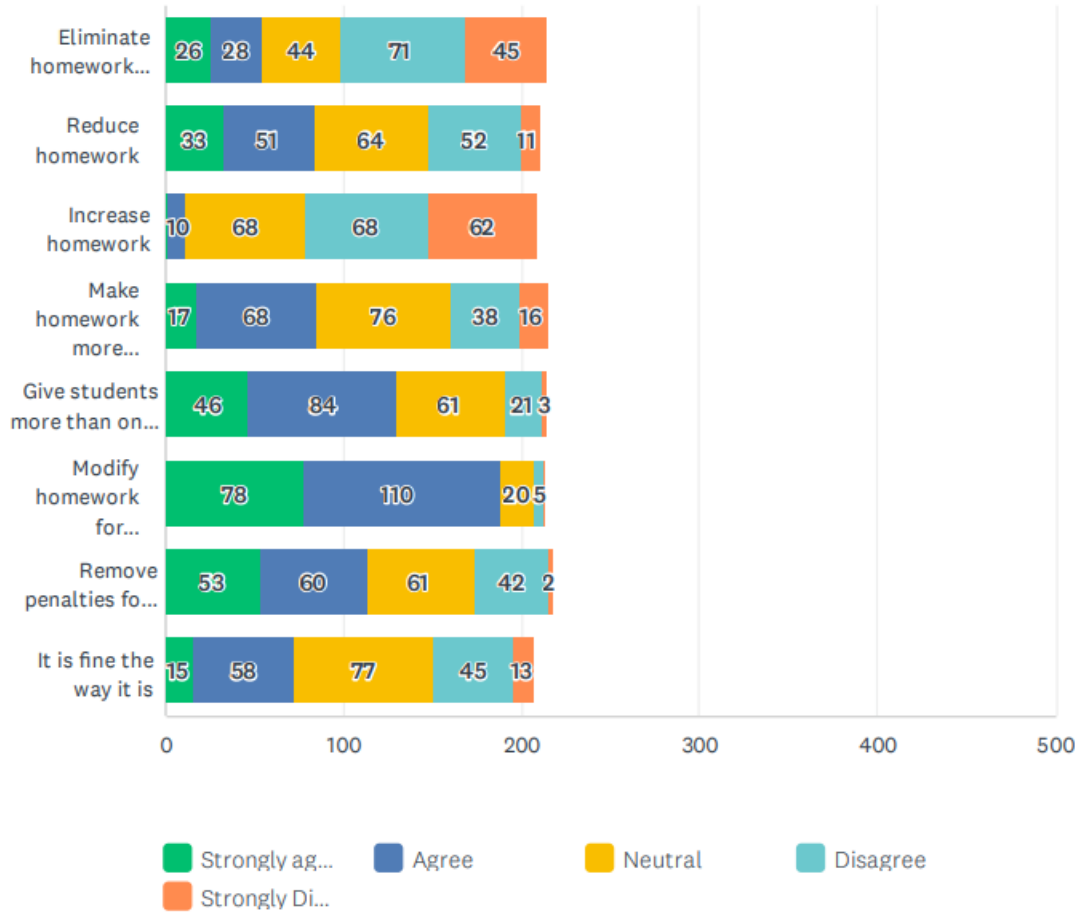
Q8 How much control should parents have over the amount and type of homework their child has?
