School Uniform Policy

Junior Infants – 6th class pupils wear the formal school uniform in full every day, except on PE days when they wear the school PE uniform.

If for some reason the uniform is not being worn, an explanatory note from home must be provided to the class teacher.

Flat black shoes or all black runners **must** be worn with the uniform. Other runners are only to be worn on PE days.

Stud earrings only are permitted in school

Pupils are not permitted to wear any make-up, nail varnish, acrylic nails etc. in school.

The formal school **uniform JI-4th class** consists of:

- Flat black shoes/boots or all black runners
- Wine pinafore or wine skirt
- White socks or white tights
- Wine jumper or wine cardigan
- Blue shirt
- School tie

The formal school **uniform 5th & 6th class** consists of:

- Flat black shoes/boots or all black runners
- Wine and navy tartan long skirt (purchased in school)
- White socks or white tights
- Wine jumper or wine cardigan
- Blue shirt
- School tie

The school **PE uniform** consists of:

- Runners with non-marking soles
- School tracksuit with school crest
- White polo shirt

In warm weather during the months of August, September, May and June the children have the option of wearing the school's "summer uniform". This consists of:

- School tracksuit top
- White polo shirt
- Plain grey cotton tracksuit shorts (knee length)

If wearing the school summer uniform children must also be wearing sun-cream coming into school. Sun cream must then be brought to school for reapplication unless it is **ONCE A DAY** sun cream.

All items of clothing and footwear must be labelled with child's name
